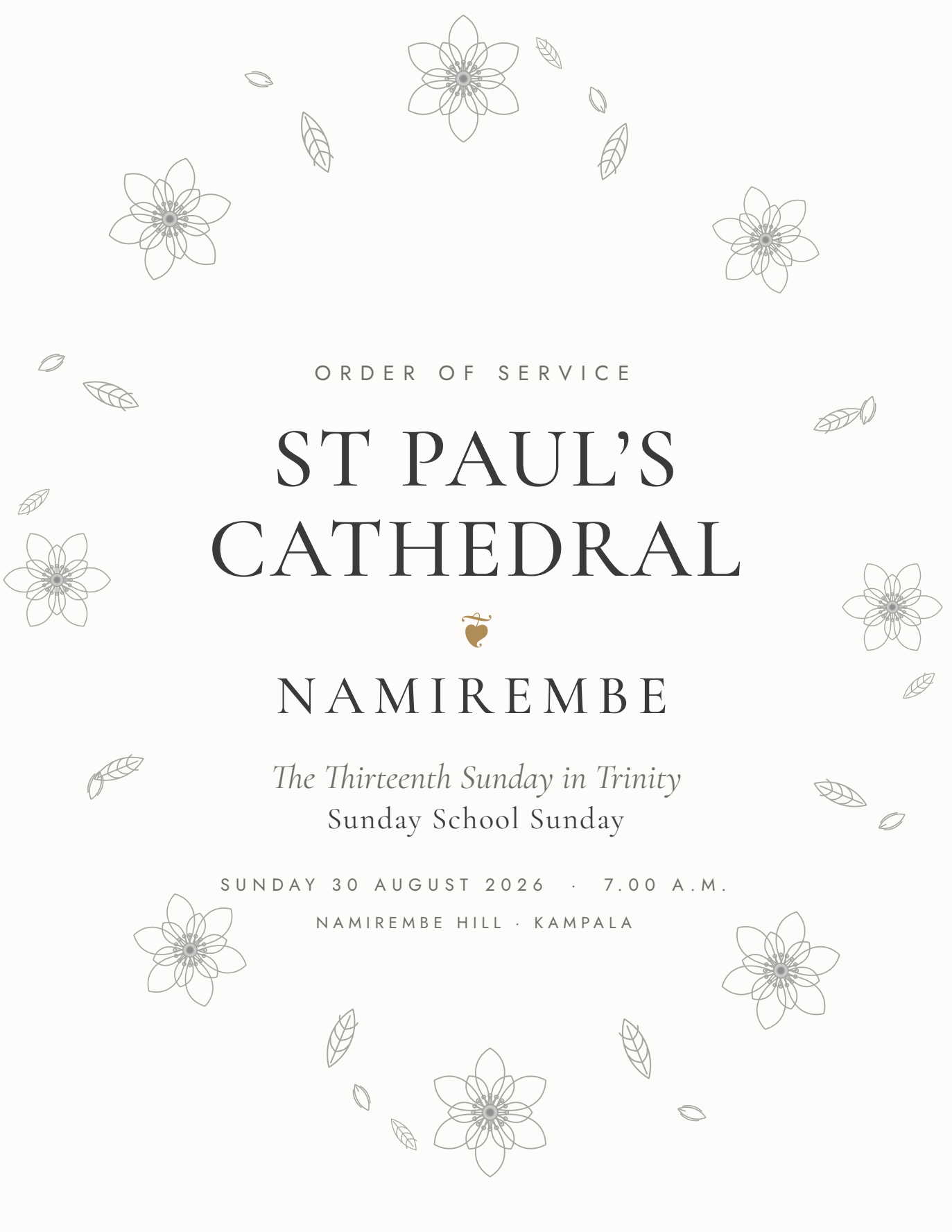

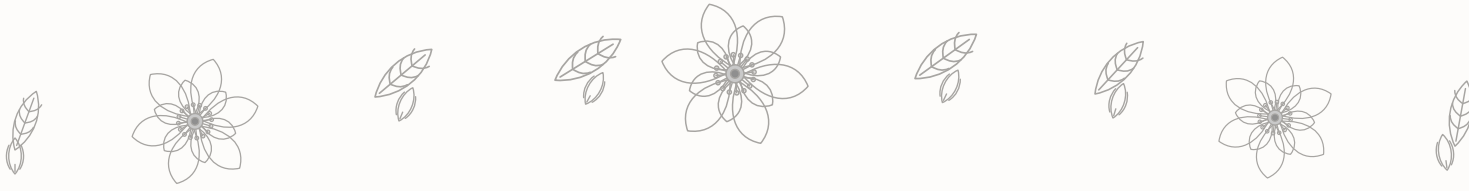

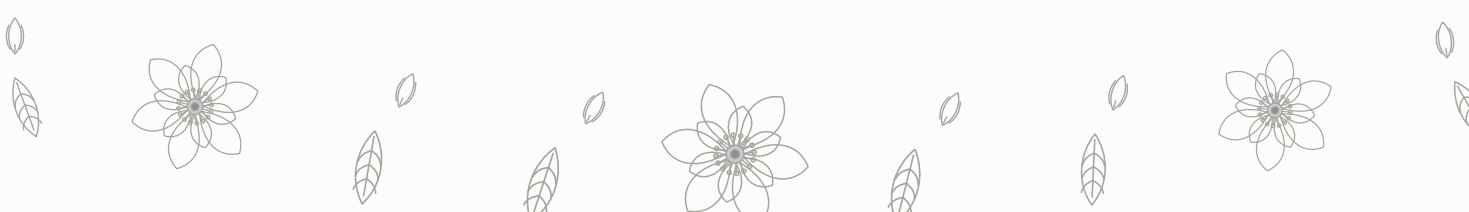

only because he loved us so.

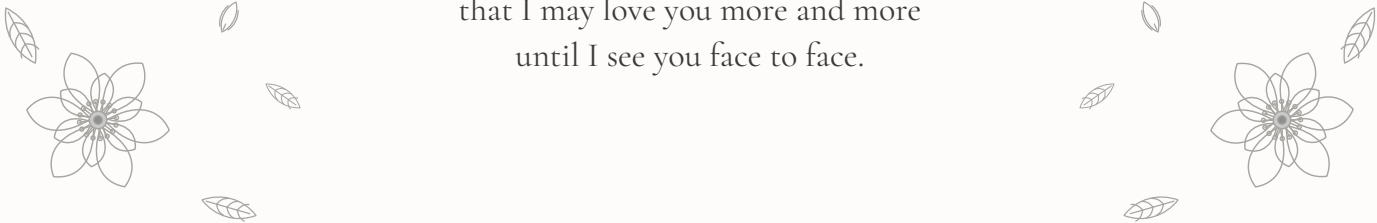
I cannot tell how he could love

and his the glory that we sing.

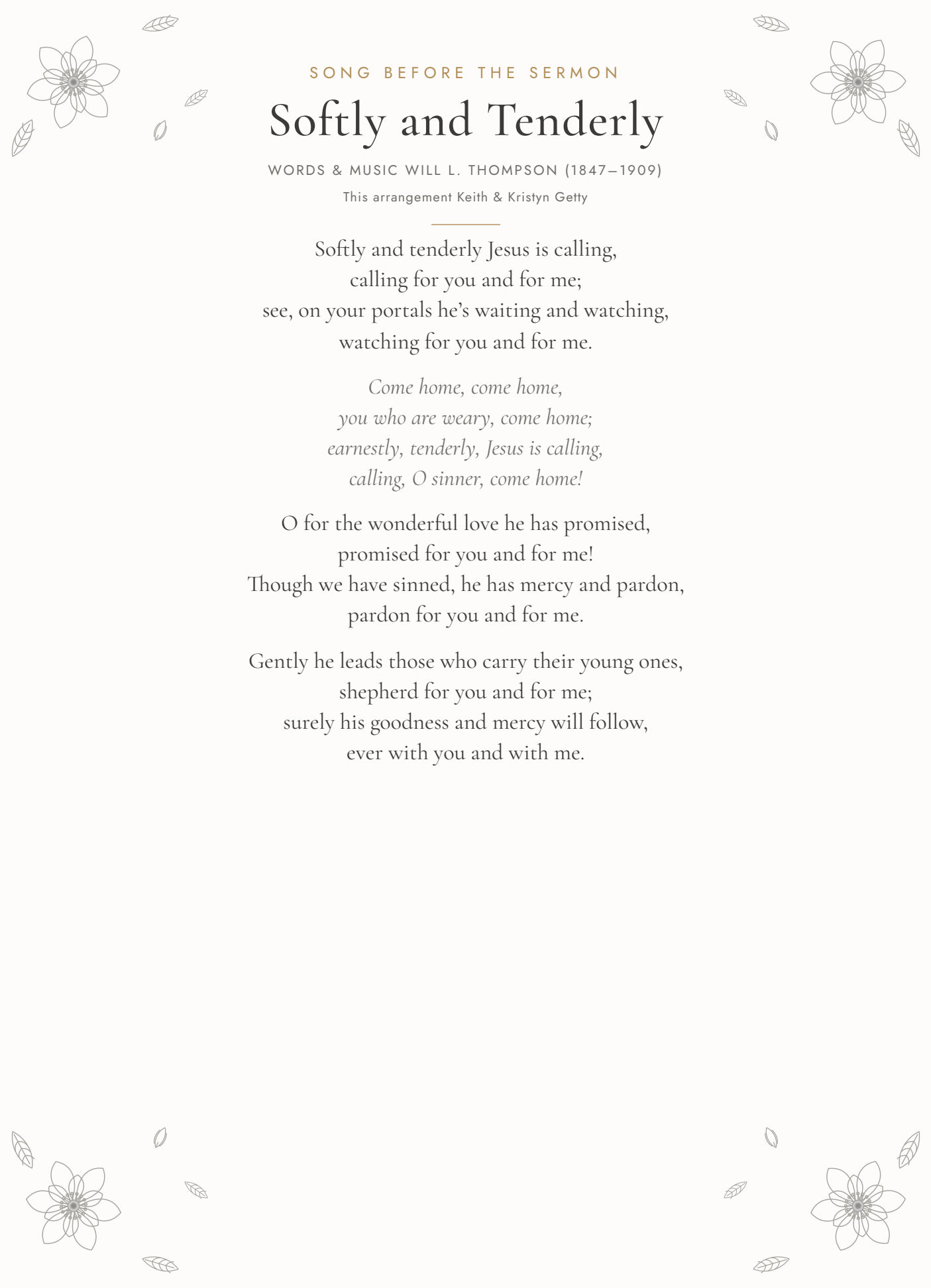
The earth is his from east to west,

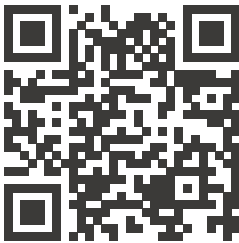

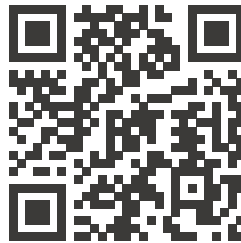

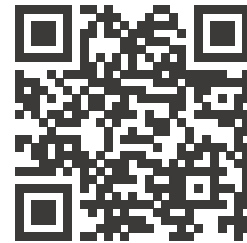
